Review of Fee's - Due to the increase in operational costs, and National wage increase over the past year our fees will increase to £10 per session for breakfast club and £12.00 per Afternoon session. This will be implemented for all bookings from **Term 3 onwards** and will take effect from **Wednesday 5th January**. This allows us to continue to have a high calibre of staff with most having or undergoing additional training to increase their knowledge and skill set. Ensuring the care your child receives with us is the best we can offer.

Personal plan's: Each child has a Personal following (GIRFEC) This is the national approach in Scotland to improving outcomes and supporting the wellbeing of your children and young people by offering the right help at the right time from the right people. Can you please make sure you read these and sign. If you have any information you would like to add to your child's personal plan, please let the team know. The more information we have about your child the more we can support them and their needs.

We ask if you have received an individual care plan for your child you return this as soon as possible.

Booking forms: Term 3 booking form will be available from the 16th of December please remember to complete and submit these as soon as possible to avoid disappointment.

Christmas Holidays – we will close from the evening of the 21st of December and will reopen on the 5th of January. We would like to wish you all the best and hope you have a lovely Christmas and break. There will still be children's activities running through out this time Christmas timetable will be available shortly.





Medication: if your child requires medication while attending OOSC, please make sure to speak to the team to ensure the correct long-term medication plan has been filled out correctly and that you have written clear signs and symptoms on the form. If your child carries their own medication and they do not have it with them the OOSC will determine

whether we can or cannot take your child, this is for their wellbeing. Sessions that cannot be attended will not be refunded.

Please note: We will not accept or administer shop bought medication; this must be prescribed by a doctor, in its original package, with the instructions, The first dose of medication should be given at home.

Illness: We would like to ask parents that if your child is not well or has been unwell that you do not take them to the OOSC. We now have some children who have weaker immune systems which can result in them becoming very unwell as a consequence. We ask that you follow the NHS exclusion for illness guidance
